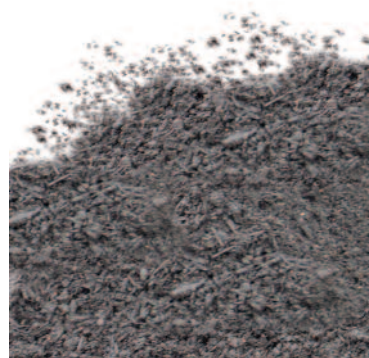

Recycling Reminder

Paper products, glass bottles and jars, aluminum and metal cans, and plastics labeled ♻ through ♻ all belong inside the blue recyclables cart. So do hard cover books, small pieces of scrap metal, and e-waste peripherals like keyboards and desktop speakers. When recycling plastic bags, stuff one bag full of the others; tie off the full bag before placing in the cart.

What: Livermore Free Drug Take-Back Event

Residents can bring their unused/unwanted prescription and over the counter medications and vitamins to the free event. Keep items in original containers with personal information marked out.

When: Saturday, September 24th from 9am to 3pm

Where: Outside the Livermore Police Station, 1110 S. Livermore Avenue

Why: Disposing unwanted drugs by pouring or flushing them down the sink and toilet pollutes the environment. Wastewater treatment plants do not remove the chemicals used in prescription and over-the-counter drugs. Treated water containing these chemicals flows to the San Francisco Bay or enters irrigation systems.
