

Mixed recycling now includes: *La Mezcla de reciclaje ahora incluye:*

PAPER PRODUCTS PRODUCTOS DE PAPEL

- corrugated cardboard & paper boxes
large or multiple pieces should be flattened and/or cut
- shredded paper
in a paper bag, secured with a staple
- aseptic boxes
juice, soup & soy milk
- hard cover books up to 40 lbs.

GLASS BOTTLES & JARS BOTELLAS Y FRASCOS DE VIDRIO

ALUMINUM & METAL

- aerosol cans (*empty*)
- scrap pieces up to 40 lbs.

PLASTICS LABELED PLÁSTICOS ETIQUETADOS

- plastic bags/*bolsas de plástico*
*Protect the environment by avoiding single-use bags.
Reuse them when possible. When recycling multiple bags, stuff one
bag full of the others; tie off the full bag before placing in your recycling.*

E-WASTE PERIPHERALS PERIFÉRICOS DE E-WASTE

- computer mice, keyboards & desktop speakers

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE HAS ITS PLACE...

and it's not inside your Livermore Sanitation collection bins.

Hazardous waste cannot be thrown out with your garbage, recyclables or organics. **Before disposing of a questionable item, check the label. If it's marked danger, warning, poisonous, toxic, or flammable, it's hazardous.**

Many hazardous items can be taken to Alameda County's local household hazardous waste collection facility. Take advantage of this free drop-off program!

THE COUNTY ACCEPTS THE FOLLOWING HAZARDOUS ITEMS:

- Pesticides
- Household & automotive batteries
- Fertilizers
- Pool & photo chemicals
- Paint/varnish
- Toxic cleaning products
- Medications/Sharps/Needles - *must be properly contained*
- Mercury-containing items - *thermometers & fluorescent lamps*
- Automotive fluids

Used motor oil and filters can also be taken to any certified collection center.

What about electronic waste?

Only e-waste peripherals like desktop keyboards, mice, speakers, modems, and cords/power supplies can go in your recycling bin.



Computers, printers, fax machines, large speakers, televisions, VCRs and similar e-waste items require special handling.
