



Proper Paint Disposal

Over 1 billion gallons of paint and similar coatings are used in our country each year. If you're painting, consider using latex paint instead of oil-based alternatives. Latex paints are water-based and more environment-friendly. When finished, put dry, empty latex paint cans with their lids separated in your blue recycling cart.

Empty oil-based paint containers, leftover paints, thinners, varnishes and strippers should be delivered to the Alameda County Household Hazardous Waste Facility at 5584 La Ribera Street in Livermore. For operating hours and directions, go to www.household-hazwaste.org or call 1-800-606-6606.



The Alameda County Household Hazardous Waste Facility accepts the following materials:

- Paint, stain, varnish, thinner, and adhesives
- Auto products such as old fuel, motor oil*, oil filters*, antifreeze, and batteries
- Household batteries*, fluorescent bulbs, cleaners, and sprays
- Garden products, including pesticides and fertilizers
- Home-generated sharps (needles, lancets, and syringes) in approved containers
- Prescription and over the counter medicines, except controlled substances
