

Keep Livermore Litter-Free

The City of Livermore spends thousands of dollars each year to remove illegally dumped litter from city streets. Please help keep Livermore clean and, in so doing, save tax dollars for other much-needed programs.

FOLLOW THESE TIPS:

- Bag small pieces of trash and recyclables before putting them in the appropriate cart. For example, put shredded paper in a paper bag sealed with one staple at the top; put the sealed bag in the blue cart.
- Handle overflow correctly. Make sure cart lids fully close.
- Use a litter bag in your car.
- Secure all materials hauled in the bed of a pickup truck.
- Call the Livermore Police Department's Litterbug Hotline at 925-371-4766 to report littering or illegal dumping.



Which Cart?

Livermore Sanitation representatives are often asked for clarification regarding where certain items should go. Here are our responses to three of the most commonly asked about items:



Plastic Packaging

If it's marked with the recycling symbol and ♻️ put it in the **RECYCLABLES**, otherwise it's likely **GARBAGE**.

Natural Wine Cork **ORGANICS**

Labels/Stickers

By themselves they're **GARBAGE**, but stuck to a letter, box, bottle or jar they're okay in the **RECYCLABLES**.

Minimize Stormwater Pollution



The discharge of pollutants and debris through the storm drain systems is the leading cause of water pollution in the Bay Area. During the dry season, pollutants build up on paved surfaces. When it rains, these accumulated pollutants are carried through the storm drain systems into the San Francisco Bay.

HERE'S WHAT YOU CAN DO:

- Put litter in its proper place. Prevent leaves and litter from getting into storm drains. Rake leaves into a pile and place them in your green cart.
- Avoid applying fertilizers or pesticides when rain is forecast.
- Check your driveway or regular parking area for build-up of auto fluids. If your car is leaking, place a drip pan under your car, then promptly take it to a professional repair shop.
- Change your oil regularly. The longer engine oil is in service, the thinner it gets and the more likely it is to leak.
- Contain used oil and used oil filters properly. If you change your own oil, contact LSI for details regarding our free used oil/filter collection program.

Keeping Your Christmas Tree?

Livermore Sanitation's special holiday tree collection service ends on January 14th but you can still have your tree composted through the regular curbside organics program.

- Remove all decorations, lights, and the stand from your once live tree, cut it into small sections, and place inside your green cart. Make sure the lid will fully close.
- Put artificial and flocked trees in the gray cart or contact us to arrange for their disposal through the Cleanup Program. Artificial and flocked trees cannot be composted.
