



Safety Checklists for the New Year

Reduce Household Toxics

- ✓ Choose safe products for tasks like cleaning, maintenance, gardening, and pest control.
- ✓ Dispose of Household Hazardous Waste properly. Visit www.stopwaste.org/hhw or call **1-800-606-6606** for information about Alameda County's drop-off facilities.



ALL-PURPOSE CLEANER
 1 quart warm water
 1 teaspoon liquid soap
 1 teaspoon borax
 1/4 cup undiluted white vinegar

Mix ingredients and store in a spray bottle. Use to clean countertops, floors, walls, carpets and upholstery.

Maintain Smoke Detectors and Carbon Monoxide Alarms

- ✓ Test existing detectors and alarms.
- ✓ Install new batteries and properly recycle the old ones (see below).
- ✓ Remove non-working detectors and alarms and install new ones.
- ✓ Dispose of non-working detectors and alarms responsibly.
 - Many manufacturers offer a mail-in program for smoke detectors and alarms. Refer to the product label, user's manual, or warranty for manufacturer's instructions.
 - Bring your non-working detectors and alarms to Alameda County's free Household Hazardous Waste drop-off facility.



Recycling Reminder

Household batteries are recyclable through your curbside collection program. Put them in a clear zipper-lock bag and place on top of your **Recyclables** cart on collection day. Please tape terminals on all lithium, 6-volt & 9-volt batteries. Cell phones can be collected too. Please bag separately.



Not Ready to Take Down Your Christmas Tree?

Livermore Sanitation's special holiday tree collection service ends on January 15th. However, you can still put your tree in the **Organics** cart after January 15th if you:

- Remove all decorations, lights, and the stand from your tree.
- Cut your tree into small sections and place it in your **Organics** cart. Make sure the lid fully closes.
- Remember that flocked and artificial trees cannot be composted and belong in your **Garbage** cart.
