The cleanest and most efficient sorting starts with you!

SUPPORT THE SORT! Please place only recyclable materials directly into your blue **RECYCLABLES** cart or bin. Do not use plastic liner bags.



JUST SAY "NO" TO CONTAMINANTS! Garbage and Organics **DO NOT** belong in the blue **RECYCLABLES** cart or bin.

MAINTAIN A CLEAN STREAM! Empty and rinse recyclable plastic, metal and glass food containers before placing them in the blue **RECYCLABLES** cart or bin.



KEEP AN EYE ON SIZE! Corrugated cardboard and paper boxes should be flattened and large pieces cut to 2' x 2' or smaller. This will maximize space in your blue **RECYCLABLES** cart or bin.



Did You Know?

40% of the material in the blue *recyclables* cart or bin is paper.
