## Happy Clog-Free Holidays!

*Don't pour Fats, Oils and Grease (FOG) down your sink drains or toilets. They will clog your pipes and sewer/septic systems.*

Manage and dispose of FOG properly using these tips:

- For small amounts of FOG, scrape out or use paper towels to wipe your pans, then place the FOG or soiled paper towels in your **ORGANICS** cart.

- For large amounts of FOG, such as used oil from a turkey fryer, collect cooled oil in a sealable container and take it to the Alameda County Household Hazardous Waste Facility in Livermore.
