SENATE BILL 1383: NEW STATE LAW AFFECTS ALL GENERATORS OF ORGANIC WASTE

SB 1383, aims to keep food and other compostable materials ("organics") out of landfills to reduce emissions that contribute to climate change.

UNDER THE LAW:

- Organic material must be collected for composting.
- Recyclables must be kept out of landfills.
