by reducing and reusing is even better.*

REUSE TO REDUCE WASTE

- Incentivize customers and employees to use reusable shopping bags, travel mugs, water bottles, and utensils.
- Offer compostable or reusable take-out containers.
- Reuse packaging and shipping materials.
- Request vendors to ship using recyclable materials such as paper and cardboard in lieu of Styrofoam and plastics.



USE LESS PAPER

- Email documents instead of printing them.
- Use electronic presentations rather than paper handouts.
- Set printers to print on both sides of paper.
- Take paperless notes on a laptop or tablet.
- Use digital marketing.
- Store files digitally.
- Use a paperless inventory tracking system.

Choose the right-sized containers and maintain clean and efficient collection area(s).

- Make sure the area around containers is clear and accessible.
- Make sure container lids close to keep out birds, critters, and rain.
- Schedule additional service when you have overflow, large items, or construction and demolition debris.
- Flatten and/or cut boxes to maximize space in the **RECYCLABLES** cart/bin.
- Please remember no glass, metal, & plastic in the **ORGANICS** cart/bin.

Important Information for Businesses Selling Food & Drinks:

California Law AB 1276 helps the environment and your bottom line. Businesses that sell food and drinks should only provide single-use foodware accessories and condiments when a customer requests them, these items include:

- Utensils
- Chopsticks
- Condiment cups and packets
- Straws
- Stirrers
- Splash sticks

DISPOSABLES UPON REQUEST ONLY



- Forks, knives, spoons and chopsticks
- Condiment cups and packets
- Straws, stirrers, and splash sticks



Items going in the **RECYCLABLES** cart or bin should be empty and clean.



Items going in the **ORGANICS** cart or bin can be in a clear plastic bag.

Recycling and Organics Service are Required!
