## **Start the New Year Right!**

**FOLLOW THESE TIPS** FOR SAFE AND EFFICIENT **COLLECTION SERVICES.** 



✓ Please place carts out before 6 a.m. Kindly store them away on non-collection days.

Carts should only be out on collection day per City Code 8.08.040. Please keep them out of public view otherwise.

- Space carts three feet apart and keep them away from obstacles (trees, mailboxes, and vehicles).
- ✓ Place materials loosely inside carts for proper emptying.
- Make sure cart wheels are against the curb and facing your home.
- ☑ Close cart lids fully. Overloaded carts can cause litter, harm the environment, and lure pests.

### Recycling Reminder - Household Batteries

- ✓ Put them in a clear zipper-lock bag and place on top of your Recyclables cart.
- ☑ Tape terminals on all lithium, 6-volt, and 9-volt batteries.
- Cell phones accepted please bag separately.



### This Year, Pledge to Waste Less!

Preventing waste starts with simple changes in daily habits.

Limit packaging & single-use items - Keep reusable bags in your car and use reusable water bottles and travel mugs.

**Reduce wasted food** - Plan meals and shop only for items that you need.

**Shop smarter, waste less** - Find alternatives to buying new.

Compostable materials like food scraps, food soiled paper, and plant trimmings are good for the soil, but bad for the landfills. When these items break down in landfills, they produce methane, a powerful greenhouse gas that contributes to climate change.

New California state law (SB 1383) aims to reduce methane emissions by keeping compostable materials out of landfills. In Alameda County, the Organics Reduction & Recycling Ordinance is in place to help residents and businesses comply with the regulations set by the state.

The cleanest and most efficient sorting starts with you, the generator. Please remember to:

- Place only recyclable materials in your blue cart.
- Properly sort! Garbage, Organics and Hazardous Waste, such as batteries and sharps, DO NOT belong in the blue recyclables cart.
